WP1	Methodology framework definition M1	<p>Task 1.2.5 European data integration and evaluation</p> <p>EFG Linked Third Parties (LTP) will collect publicly available data at national level on deep drilling programmes, geophysical and geochemical explorations and any kind of geo-scientific data related to the potential deep metal enrichments. They will also collect data on the national geothermal potential. Guidelines/templates for data collection will be provided by EFG. EFG will also supervise data collection, summarise the datasets at European level, and identify the data gaps. EFG will provide the datasets to the WP leader, and act as a link between the project partners and the LTPs. The task provides a "European outlook" on data availability (no processing of data) in order to identify data gaps.</p>
WP6	Roadmapping and Preparation for Pilots M24	<p>Task 6.2.5 European Outlook</p> <p>EFG Linked Third Parties will assess the geological data on suitable ore-bearing formations and geothermal projects, which were collected in WP1, in relation with the potential application of the CHPM technology. This work will combine these data with the outcomes of the most recent predictive metallogenic models. Only existing datasets will be utilised, no new surveys will be carried out. EFG will provide guidelines and templates for data collection and data assessment, supervise data collection, and summarise the national reports at a European level. The task provides a "European outlook" on prospective CHPM development areas.</p>
